Why native plants? Native plants are *the* landscaping plants of choice for people that want to attract birds and wildlife to their backyard and create a healthier environment. Native species, unlike imported species, evolved with the local environments, and are often more attractive to wildlife and birds, need less care once established, and help to protect our environment.

Directions to Meadowood Nursery -- 24 Meadowood Drive, Hummelstown

From the north: take Route 81 to Exit 77. Proceed south/east on Route 39 approximately 3 miles and turn right on Red Top Road. Proceed 1 mile and turn right on Long Lane Drive. Take the first left onto Meadowood Drive and at the "Y" at the end of the road, stay to the left and take the drive on the left up the hill to the nursery. Follow signs and directions for parking.

From the south: follow signs to Hershey Park. From Hershey Park Drive in front of the Giant Center, follow Route 39 north/west approximately 3 miles and turn left on Red Top Road. Proceed 1 mile and turn right on Long Lane Drive to the first left onto Meadowood Drive. Proceed as above.
